

# Fun & Easy Watercolor Background Two Cards

## Paper Pieces:

- Fluid Watercolor Paper
- 5 1/2" x 8 1/2" Misty Moonlight Cardstock (for first card base)
- 4" x 5 1/4" Basic White Cardstock (for inside)
- 4 1/4" x 11" Thick Basic White Cardstock (for second card base)
- Scrap Basic White Cardstock for die cut (for mask and 2<sup>nd</sup> card) and sentiment
- Scrap Crushed Curry Cardstock for die cut (for 1<sup>st</sup> card)

## Other Supplies:

- Many Layered Blossoms Dies (2021-2022 Annual Catalog p. 20 & 158)
- Misty Moonlight 1/8" Cotton Ribbon from Ribbon Combo Pack (Spring 2022 Mini p. 43)
- Polished Dots (Spring 2022 Mini p. 23)
- Opal Rounds (2021-2022 Annual Catalog p. 143)

## Instructions:

### *First Card*

1. Die Cut thicker large die from Basic White and thinner large die from Crushed Curry cardstock
2. Place Basic White die cut on piece of Fluid 100 Watercolor Paper. Wet paper with water and watercolor in sections over the top of the die cut, cleaning the water painter between colors
3. Pull die cut off of watercolor paper and set to side to use on 2<sup>nd</sup> card
4. Adhere crushed curry die cut over the image on water color paper

5. Cut water colored background to 3 7/8" x 5 1/8"; adhere to Misty Moonlight cardbase
6. Stamp Sentiment on 1/2" strip of cardstock, Adhere to card front using dimensionals.
7. Adhere Polished Dots on card front.
8. Make bow from Misty Moonlight ribbon and adhere to card front using glue dot.

#### *Second Card*

1. Adhere watercolored die cut to front of Basic White card base.
2. Stamp sentiment on card front
3. Adhere Opal Rounds to centers of flowers on die cut
4. Add Wink of Stella to die cut
